POSITION OVERVIEW:

Under the general direction of the HES Manager, the Environmental Specialist monitors air, water and soil quality at the Mountain Pass operations, and assists the Senior Environmental Specialist and HES Manager with compliance obligations at the facility.

KEY RESPONSIBILITIES (essential position functions):

- Collect groundwater, soil, and ambient air quality samples to meet regulatory and internal requirements
- Package samples for shipment and ensure chain-of-custody documentation is correct.
- Complete routine site wide inspections (wildlife, storm water controls/BMPs, pond freeboard, liner integrity, landfill covers, soil moisture, and instrumentation) to remain in compliance with regulations.
- Perform water supply bacteriological sampling.
- Perform frequent equipment and instrumentation calibrations.
- Maintain existing field equipment and instruments, ordering new, and providing oversight to third-party repair vendors and suppliers.
- Assist the Waste Compliance Specialist in carrying out waste management tasks as assigned.
- Evaluate proposed process modifications, additions and changes to identify potential environmental and/or safety concerns and recommends appropriate safeguards.
- Provide soil sampling in response to releases and clean-up actions and coordinate with internal and external laboratories for analyses.
- Assist operations departments in conducting routine opacity readings and pond inspections.
- Cooperate in the implementation of Molycorp's management systems to ensure consistent conformance to both internal and external requirements as well as working towards continuous improvement.

POSITION REQUIREMENTS:

- B. S. Degree in Science or Engineering and a minimum of 2 years of experience in environmental sampling.
- Good communication and interpersonal skills
- Good environmental awareness and environmental ethics
- Good computer skills required with familiarity with word processing, spreadsheet, database, accounting and data acquisition software.
- Understanding of local, state and federal environmental regulations.
- Bachelor's degree in physical science, engineering or a related field
